The Transit Center at Boardwalk Square project involved designing shelter buildings as well as site geometry, grading, utilities, and approximately 4,700 square yards of concrete pavement. This transfer transit center is a first of its kind in the Kansas City metropolitan area due to its unique clock tower, provisions for future ITS (Intelligent Transportation Systems) adaptabilities, and well planned accessibility to the public and neighboring areas.
