The Transit Gateways Study, initiated by the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority, is a two-part study conducted as a first step in implementing Kansas City's Metropolitan Transit Initiative. The second phase of the project involves developing prototypical designs for neighborhood, local, and regional transit centers. Bus/rail transfer modes were also investigated.

Taliaferro & Browne and subconsultant HNTB studied five U.S. cities' bus transit centers — hubs where several routes converge to offer transfer opportunities and around which transit-oriented development can occur.
